### **Piyyut Parasha: Lekh Lekha**

O Lord of all creations, who is noble in His splendor,  
Who moves around the heavenly regions without touching them by hand.  
He reveals mysteries, and who knows His secret?  
Light dwells with Him, and there is nothing aside from Him.  
He chose the father of a multitude, His beloved,  
And took him out of Ur Kasdim, and made his footsteps straight,  
For he had destroyed the crafted idols with all his might. The fruit of his mouth was a tree of life,  
and he acquired souls through his instruction.  
Hofra' suffered rebuke, and his eyes saw his [own] destruction,  
For he had set his hand on [Abraham's] bosom wife.  
And in the morning, he beseeched [Abraham], and told him of his sufferings.  
When the five princes gathered together, each one prepared,  
[Abraham] unsheathed [his weapons for] his retainers, and rescued Lot, his beloved.  
And Malkizedeq blessed [Abraham] to El 'Elyon, who had helped him,  
And had delivered his enemies, and all who would plunder him, into his hand.  
Adonai's word came to [Abraham] in a vision, to instruct him,  
To inform him the secret of end-times, and to tell him;  
[When] a deep sleep fell upon him, to make him tremble.  
[God] called him unblemished, and brought him into the tradition of the covenant, the seal of His  
witness,  
And [he instructed him] to distance the handmaiden and her son from Isaac, to separate him—  
For in Isaac alone will [Abraham's descendants] be called his progeny, such that [Abraham] can

God loves.

diligently,

The father informed his children of [God's] truth and oneness.
